



## Allan B. Rogers Editorial Award 2010 Call for Entries

The New England Newspaper & Press Association is now accepting nominations for the 18<sup>th</sup> *Allan B. Rogers Editorial Award*. Editors are invited to enter their best editorial on a local subject.

The award honors the editor of The Eagle-Tribune (North Andover, MA) who died in 1964 at the age of 31. Past winners include The Sun of Lowell, The Cape Cod Times of Hyannis, the Kennebec Journal of Augusta, the Journal Inquirer of Manchester, and The Hartford Courant.

The award will recognize the best editorial on a local subject published by a NENPA-member newspaper during the past year -- from June 1, 2009 to May 31, 2010. The competition will include editorials from a wide variety of newspapers in New England, regardless of circulation size and frequency of publication. The winner will be announced at an awards luncheon at the NENPA fall conference, which will be held on October 21, 2010 at the Crowne Plaza in Natick, MA.

Editors may enter just one editorial on a local subject for the Allan B. Rogers Editorial Award. Please fill out the entry form and send it with two copies of the editorial and a check for your \$75 entry fee. Make your check payable to the *New England Newspaper & Press Association*.
